Our favourite of all the Grande Marque Champagnes, made of 85% grand and premier cru grapes matured for twice as long as the appellation requirement. Elegant, reserved and harmonious.

Gobillard, N.V Brut Grande Réserve Premier Cru

Made by an excellent quality, small producer located between Taittinger and Dom Pérignon in the village of Hautvilliers, now in its 4th generation of production. This is an elegant and rounded Champagne with a bouquet of citrus blossom that precedes a delicate array of greengages and honey.

Rosé

Pays d'Oc La Voile Rosé
Languedoc, France 2022

A beautifully delicate rosé from the South of France. From the heart of the Languedoc in the south of France at Les Vignobles Foncalieu winery, a cooperative that has been making wine since 1967. Pale pink in colour showing flavours of ripe red cherries and wild strawberry. The mouth is fresh and aromatic, and leads into a refreshing finish laced with zesty character.

Provence, France 2022

Provence is the birthplace of rosé wines, and this classic light Rosé is made by a local collective of producers that was founded in 1912. The quality of the wine is supported by a cultivation process that respects the soil. It is elegant and fragrant, with notes of strawberry, cherry and citrus, with good body and a long finish.

Pézenas, France 2022

Jean Claude is fourth generation in the family vineyards. As a young man, he was sent by his father to work for the legendary Italian winemaker Giorgio Grai. He has combined the best of old world and new world experience and is making very admirable wines.

1 Paparuda Pinot Grigio, Philip & Elvira Cox
Timiș, România 2022

This English husband and wife team are fast turning the Cramele Recas estate into the most successful winery in Romania. Exhaustively modernised over the last decade, they produce a Pinot Grigio considered truly a connoisseurs wine. Fresh with notes of lemon & green apple and a steely minerality on the finish.

2 Ladera Verde Sauvignon Blanc, Luis Felipe
Maipo, Chile 2022

A winemaker whose history dates back to 1976. Crisp and fresh with limey fruit, a hint of herbs and a twist of melon. A dependable and friendly wine, an excellent introduction to Chile

- 3 Rupe Secca Grillo, Stefano Girelli
Marsala, Sicily 2022

The result of a crossing between Catarratto and Moscato di Alessandria grapes, producing crisp and delightful wines. These grapes are handpicked from the best vineyards in the area. An intense bouquet and a lovely palate of citrus and tropical fruit flavours is balanced with refreshing acidity.

- 4 l'Abeille Picpoul de Pinet, Les Costieres de Pomerols,
Languedoc, France 2022

Often referred to as the 'Chablis of the South' this Picpoul is bright and Zesty. Light lemon-green in colour, crisp, youthful and full of fresh citrus fruit flavours, accented with subtle hints of fennel, green pepper and lime zest. l'Abeille meaning 'the bee', pays homage to this wine's local name 'lip stinger'.

6 **Bernon Albarino, Rias Baixas, Bodegas Aquitania**

Galicia, Spain 2022

Creamy fruit, with plenty of yellow peach flavour and a good touch of underlying minerality. Complex and interesting wine from Galicia in north west Spain.

7 **Macon-Chardonnay, Mallory & Benjamin Talmard**

Burgundy, France 2022

Made from the Chardonnay grapes that grow in the Talmard vineyards around the village of Chardonnay - thought to be the geographical origin of the grape! This wine is unoaked, gentle, elegant, hints of apple and quince, a subtle minerality and a long, fresh, dry finish.

8 **Sancerre, Domaine Doucet**

Loire, France 2022

The Doucet family wine growing expertise has been dedicated to producing fine Sancerre since 1975. This is an elegant and refreshing wine with overtones of gooseberry and citrus flavours on the palate. It is intense and aromatic with tropical fruit flavours, and offers a great balance of freshness and flavour.

- 9 **Chardonnay, Chablis 1^{er} Cru 'Montmains' Domaine Fillon**
Burgundy, France 2021

The Fillon family have been making wine in the same village for over 100 years, with Herve being the 4th generation to run this vineyard. This is a fantastic example of a Chablis. Structured and fresh, with pleasing minerality.

- 10 **Domaine Patrick Miolane, Puligny Montrachet**
Burgundy, France 2022

The Miolane estate is an ancient family run 7 hectare estate run by Patrick Miolane and his daughter Barbara. They work without sprays, and harvest by hand. Notes of hawthorn, holly, and candied apple, a burgundy with a modern touch, lighter oak influence and richer fruit character.

Pézenas, France 2021

Claude is fourth generation in the family vineyards. As a young man, he worked for the legendary Italian winemaker Giorgio Grai, who taught him the art of blending different grapes. He's combined the best of old and new world experience here.

12 **Malbec, Carlos and Nicolás Munoz-Lopez**
Mendoza, Argentina 2021

In the early 1950s, Don Juan Munoz-Lopez began farming grapevines. His sons continue this legacy. Notes of ripe plum fruits, sweet tannins, dark chocolate and mocha. Full-bodied with juicy tannins and flavour that linger.

13 **Rioja Crianza Journey Collection, Ramón Bilbao**
Rioja, Spain 2019

From a much admired Spanish producer, established in 1924 that focuses on grapes grown at higher altitudes to produce fresher wines. This is a powerful wine with an intense nose of balanced red and black fruits. Soft tannins, full of black fruit with an intriguing sour note

- 14 **Nero D'Avola, Rupe Secca**
Sicily, Italy **2022**

The Nero D'Avola grape thrives in these sun-drenched Sicilian vineyards, famed for its deep, rich, vibrant, concentrated fruit, with notes of black pepper, dark chocolate, ripe plums and spice.

- 15 **Valpolicella, Cantina di Negrar, Corvina, Daniele Accordini**
Verona, Italy **2021**

Corvina is the queen of Veronese red grapes, and this is a stunning example from a winery founded in 1933, where sustainable viticulture is key. Bright ruby red, with a nose filled with the perfume of vanilla and cherry. Well rounded yet light, and peppered with soft tannins.

- 15 **Quinta do Val da Figueira Reserva, Joao Calem**
Douro, Portugal **2016**

From one of the oldest and finest vineyards in the Douro. The vineyard still uses traditional methods to make a wine with a velvet texture despite being unfiltered. It is both gentle and deep, well-rounded, retaining complex flavours and benefitting from eight year bottle age.

16 **Pavia Casareggio Barbera d'Asti**

Pavia Casareggio 2021

From a small, family owned/run winery in the beautiful rolling hills of Algliano Terme. Intense ruby red with black fruit aromas and subtle spices. A pleasing rusticity on the palate that finishes with balanced tannins and well integrated oaky spiciness.

17 **Château Gros Caillou, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Dupuy Family**
Bordeaux, France 2015

Chateau Gros Caillou has been owned by the Dupuy family for nearly six generations in the commune of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens. With an average vine age of 35 years, this wine is from the best vines both in terms of age and terroir. An elegant wine full of raspberries and stewed fruit, with a compelling fragrance of leather.

18 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Cuvée Les Pierres, Cellier des Princes**
Rhône, France 2021

From a vineyard located in Courthezon, North-East of the appellation Châteauneuf du Pape. The land features round pebbles and sandy soils. Grapes are hand-picked at peak maturity and immediately transported to the winery to avoid juice release and oxidation. Complex and elegant with aromas of red currant, red cherries, black berries with spicy overtones such as lavender, thyme and rosemary.

19 **Gevrey–Chambertin, Joseph Drouhin**
Burgundy, France 2021

Vines have been cultivated in Gevrey since 630AD, when a certain Bertin decided to emulate the monks, his neighbours. The wine he made turned out to be spectacular! This is a wonderful example, with notes of cherry, mushroom, and truffle, with a fresh breath of liquorice

20 **Domaine Jean Javillier, Pommard 1er Cru**
Burgundy, France 2021

Now run by the 5th generation of the Javillier family. This tiny estate covers a total of 7.5 hectares, organic since 1972. Crafted naturally from pinot noir from one of the village's 27 Premier Cru sites. Entirely hand harvested, with minuscule yields and limited production. Elegant, round and ripe, with discreet tannins and hints of blackberry, chocolate and leather.

- 21 **Mas Amiel Maury Vintage Rouge**
Languedoc, France 2020

On a 14 hectare plot on the hills overlooking the town of Deveze, grapes are harvested and fermented slowly for 20 days before arresting with a small quantity of grape spirit and aged 1 year in vats. Fresher and brighter than most dessert reds with cherry, strawberry and sweet liquorice notes.

- 22 **Hétszőlő Tokaji, Michel Reybier**
Tokaj, Hungary 2016

From an estate dating back to 1502, this is an outstanding example of the Tokaj regions ability to create world class wines. Aromas of citrus, elderflower, linden blossom and fresh tropical fruit notes, along with elegant minerality and acidity. The residual sugar and the refreshing acidity give an excellent balance.
